MAIN PROGRAM COMPONENTS ARE...

- » A two-year advocacy experience.
- » Seven full day Sunday training sessions during Year One, which include: learning about Israeli history, journalistic and video production training, advocacy training and guest speakers.
- » A 10-day fact-finding Mission to Israel (early June 2012) with experiences as diverse as travelling along Israel's northern border and attending a rock concert in Tel Aviv.
- » Advocacy experience in Year Two which includes: lobbying in Washington, D.C., publishing a magazine, creating advocacy posters and videos, and organizing high school events.

APPLICATION PROCESS...

- » June 3, 2011 – application and essays due (application available on the website)
- » June-August 2011 – individual interviews
- » Program cost is \$750 for the first year, and \$300 in the second year.
