

GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS REQUESTING HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT FOR HEBREW STUDIES AT AKIVA

Many area high schools grant language credit to students studying Hebrew at Akiva. In order to maintain the high level of learning which this relationship requires, we have developed the following guidelines and expectations:

Guidelines of expectations

To receive language credit for Hebrew classes, students must comply with the following:

- Attend 85% of classes and participate in classroom activities
- Complete all homework assignments
- Achieve a passing grade in all unit tests
- Successfully complete all quizzes

Grading

The unit tests constitute 25% of the student grade, homework, quizzes, attendance and classroom participation constitute the other 75%.

Students requesting high school credit, who have missed more than 15% of the classes are required to contact the office to review your options to meet the necessary requirements in order to achieve a grade. This year students are able to miss 3 classes during the first semester and 5 classes during the second semester.
