

3.5 Hours, Neve Sha'anan & South Tel Aviv

This tour explores the fascinating neighborhood of Neve Sha'anan as a microcosm of Israel. In recent years, Israel has seen a significant rise in non-Jewish immigrants such as migrant workers, asylum-seekers and refugees, presenting new challenges to the Jewish State. With our own eyes we will see how diverse groups have left their impact on Israel and on the neighborhood.

Elliot Glassenberg is an American-Canadian-Israeli Jewish educator-activist. Elliot teaches and advocates on topics relating to Jewish pluralism and inclusion, refugee rights, LGBTQ rights and human rights, and his educator-activist approach focuses on the application of Judaism for social change. Elliot is a senior educator at BINA: The Jewish Movement for Social Change and a leading activist for refugee rights in Israel. Elliot is co-chair of Right Now: Advocates for Asylum Seekers in Israel, a blogger for The Times of Israel, and has published in Haaretz, The Jerusalem Post, The Jewish Week, and elsewhere. Elliot also recently served as Central Shaliach for the Kibbutz Movement in North America. A native of Chicago, Elliot currently lives in Jaffa and holds a B.A. from McGill University, and an M.A. in Jewish Education and an M.A. in Jewish Literature from the Jewish Theological Seminary.

Vadim Blumin is one of the founders of the 1.5 Generation: Russian-speaking Young Adults group and a member of the Content Committee of Limmud-FSU bringing the young voice of the second generation immigrants from Russia to Israel. Today, he serves as the director of the "Mandel Program for Excellence". In the past he was a content and training specialist at Makom, the Strategic Content Lab of the Jewish Agency, and headed its education department in St. Petersburg, Russia. He served also as the executive director of 1+1: Association of Immigrant Youth, was alumni of the GVANIM program for pluralism and leadership, as well as the JDC-ELKA training program for directors-general of voluntary organizations. Learn about the 1.5 Generation and their push for civil rights and equality, their refusal of conversion, and their quest for an open discourse about feminism, LGBTQ rights, culture and art. Vadim lives in Ramat Gan with his husband, Roman, and their daughter, Danielle.

The SHAFDAN is the largest wastewater treatment plant in Israel and currently treats 360,000 m3/day of municipal wastewater, about 92% of its treatment capacity. Waste sludge from the plant is discharged to the Mediterranean Sea through a marine outfall. The SHAFDAN is committed to ending the disposal of its sludge to the sea by the end of 2016 by providing a land-based biosolids management program that produces a Class A biosolids for agricultural use. In order to implement this strategy, a number of large-scale construction projects were undertaken. These projects include a new sludge thickening and dewatering facility, updated headworks, a new primary treatment facility, and a new 3-stage thermophilic anaerobic digestion facility. The total capital cost of these projects is estimated to be US \$300 million. This paper describes the principal components of these projects and their design parameters.

Eliaz Cohen was born in 1972 to a pluralistic religious family, Eliaz Cohen was named after his uncle, Eliezer Feldman who was killed in the Sinai Campaign of 1956. In 1979, his family moved to Elkana in Samaria, where he grew up. Growing up both as part of a bereavec family and being neighbors to Palestinian villages influenced his world view, both features that find expression in his work. Eliaz studied in the B'nei Akiva Yeshivot, and served in the armored division of the Israeli army. In 1994, he began to publish his writings in various magazines and newspapers, starting with prose writings which were followed b! poetry.

He is an editor of the poetry journal Mashiv Haru'ach and the author of six published collections of poetry. Additionally, a Hebrew-English bilingual edition of his poetry was published in 2010 by Toby Press, and a collection of his poetry has been translated to French by Levant Publishing House.

He was the recipient of the Prime Minister Award for Literature in 2006.

In recent years, Eliaz has stood out as a social activist dealing with issues such as religion and state, narrowing socioeconomic gaps, and the sanctity of life. During 2009 he was one of founders of Yerushalom, a movement for dialogue and peace between Palestinians and Israeli settlers, that led to the founding of the Roots Center in

2014. Another initiative he is leading is Light Tag-against the Jewish vandalism and hateful attacks that go under the name "Price Tag," and the new peace initiative "A Land for All - 2 States, 1 Homeland."

Eliaz is a member of Kibbutz Kfar-Etzion, along with his wife and four children.

Tour of Sigalit Landau: The Burning Sea exhibit at the Israel Museum Activity Blogger - Ori Balkan

For twenty years, Sigalit Landau has made art – both monumental and profoundly intimate – at the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth.

Inspired by this primal place, Landau creates works of great beauty that address fragile dualities: life and death, injury and healing, destruction and hope.

The Burning Sea presents a selection of Landau's Dead Sea artworks of the last two decades, from glittering saltencrusted sculptures through video works and photographs. The exhibition also premieres a new video trilogy that relates to her idea of building a bridge over the lake, a project that has engaged Landau for many years, first emerging in her memorable installation at the 2011 Venice Biennale, which is represented here for the first time in Israel.

Following Landau into the salt-saturated water and experiencing both the magnificence and the devastation of this endangered site, the exhibition closes on an optimistic note, with the hope that we can build a bridge over burning water.




This is all thanks to the man and legend in his time, Pinhas Rutenberg.
