My siblings, Ido and Tamar, are currently students, but I can already see a bright future ahead for both of them ✨

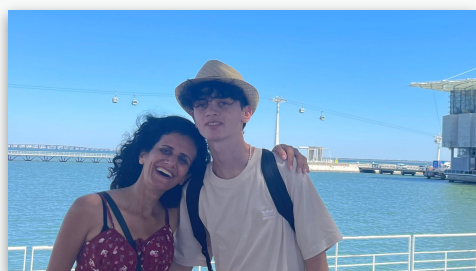
Now that we got the emotional part out of the way... let's move on! 😊
